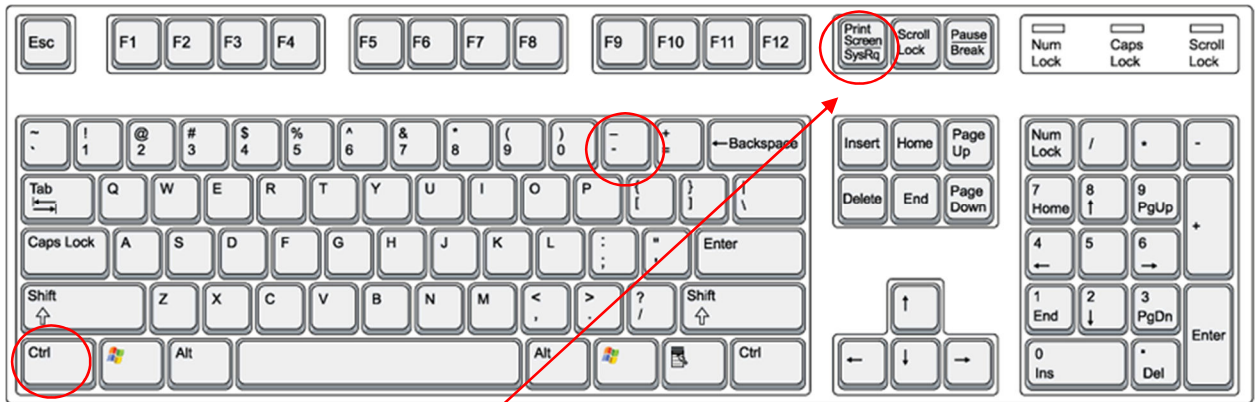


## How to get your GPA

1. Go to [https://www.flvc.org/CCRE/hs\\_accessbf.jsp](https://www.flvc.org/CCRE/hs_accessbf.jsp)
2. Log in. If you do not know your Florida Student Identifier Number use your SSN with no dashes or spaces and add an 'X' at the end.
3. Scroll to MY PROGRESS to the **"GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) REQUIREMENTS"** section. Make sure your name still appears in the screen under **STUDENT INFORMATION**.
4. If you need to make the screen smaller to show your name and your GPA click the **CTRL** key and the **-** key until it is small enough on the screen



5. Then click the **Print Screen** on the keyboard. The image is now loaded to your clipboard.
